Outreach Opportunities

Otterbein Thrift Store Month: Otterbein United Methodist Thrift Store is a ministry of the church serving the 46218 zip code area and beyond in the name of Jesus. The store sales "clothes only" priced at 25 cents each or if cash is low, customers are encouraged to take what they need. All money received through the Thrift Store goes to pay utilities for the house its located in along with 10% going to support Royal Family Kids Camp. The store is open every Saturday from 10am to 2pm. Donations are accepted and any clothes that are not used is donated to St. Vincent de Paul who gives to people in need. The store has been open for more than 10 years trying to put good in a neighborhood that needs it. The Thrift Store is more than a place for clothes, its a place that encourages peace, love, fellowship, community, prayer and the love of Christ. In 2016 the Thrift Store collected \$922 and that = 3688 items sold plus clothing that was given away for
