

9 AM Adult Forum: Einstein's God: Science, Faith and the Life of Wonder will be presented during the next several weeks during Adult Forum. **This week:** The Hindu physicist V. V. Raman has been described as a trans-cultural voyager who finds meaning in life as he courses from physics to philosophy, from music to metaphysics, from Bhagavad-Gita to Gregorian chants. He's an esteemed voice in the global dialogue between scientific and religious perspectives that is often obscured by headlines of a science-religion clash. Where American culture finds cognitive dissonance, V. V. Raman describes a consonance of experience.


