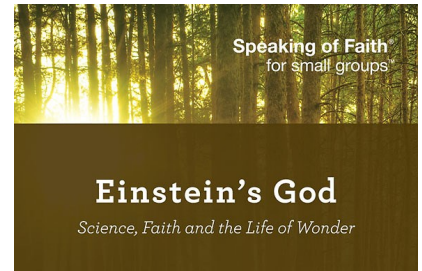
Worship and Feast Days

Christian Education

9 AM Adult Forum: Einstein's God: Science, Faith and the Life of Wonder will be presented during the next several weeks during Adult Forum. **Our final presentation on Nov. 22nd:** Albert Einstein did not believe in a personal deity, but his life and his science were rich with wonder, and he often made half-serious, half-whimsical reference to God or the Lord. Most famous is Einstein's tantalizing line, often quoted out of context, that "God does not play dice with the universe." In this session, we'll learn what he meant when he said that, and we'll probe the contours of what Einstein called his cosmic religious sense.
