## Worship and Feast Days

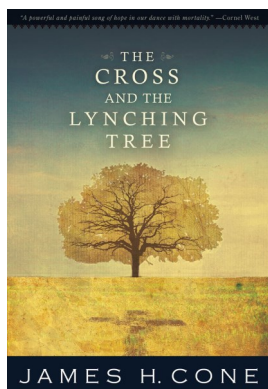

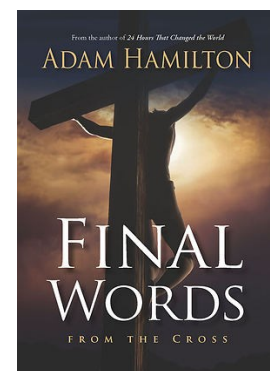
