Outreach Focus - Otterbein Thrift Ministry Month: Otterbein United Methodist Thrift Store is a ministry of the church serving the 46218 zip code area and beyond in the name of Jesus. The store sells "clothes only" priced at 25 cents each or if cash is low, customers are encouraged to take what they need. All money received through the Thrift Store goes to pay utilities for the house its located in along with 10% going to support Royal Family Kids Camp. The store is open every Saturday from 10 AM to 2 PM. Donations are accepted and any clothes that are not used is donated to St. Vincent de Paul who gives to people in need. The store has been open for more than 10 years trying to put good in a neighborhood that has so much bad. The Thrift Store is more than a place for clothes, its a place that encourages peace, love, fellowship, community, prayer and the love of Christ. In 2015 the Thrift Store collected \$1308.00 in sales and that = 5232 items sold. That does not include 100's of items given away for free. For more information please see Cathy Scott.
