



Message from the City of Fishers

On August 8th, the City of Fishers was notified by the Hamilton County Health Department of positive West Nile Virus samples in eleven locations throughout the county. Hamilton County Health Department will begin spraying affected areas within one mile of each of the positive sample site. All spraying activities are weather dependent and have an approximate start time of 8:30 PM or local sunset.



Mosquito Prevention Tips:

- Remove standing water in ponds, ditches, clogged rain gutters, flower pots, plant saucers, puddles, buckets, garden equipment and cans.
- Check for items that might hold water including barbecues, toys, pool covers, tarps, plastic sheeting, boats, canoes, and trash.
- Avoid mosquitoes by staying indoors at dawn and dusk when the bugs are most active.
- Wear long-sleeved shirts and long pants while outdoors.
- Apply insect repellent that contains DEET. Use only 10% DEET on children, and make sure everyone washes their hands well so that they do not get any product in their eyes or mouth. *Follow directions carefully.*
