<u>Cuddle Buddies</u>: For anyone who enjoys rocking infants, Deacon Cathy has a new outreach opportunity! Eskenazi Health will soon launch an infant comfort and companionship volunteer program called Cuddle Buddies. The purpose of Cuddle Buddies is to aid infants in development. Being held is a natural, no-

cost intervention that can help with pain management, better sleep, faster growth and shorter hospital stays. Volunteers will rock, hold, sing to, talk to and be there to comfort babies in the Eskenazi Health Neonatal Intensive Care Unit. The volunteers will not replace parents. This service will be offered when family members need to leave the hospital for work or other obligations. Recruitment is already underway for volunteers willing to commit to a long-term partnership with Eskenazi Health to help grow the program. Volunteers will work one three-hour shift
