Holy Week Services

<u>Maundy Thursday, 7 PM March 29th</u>: We remember the Last Supper with a service that includes, for those who wish to participate, the washing of each other's feet. Following the service, some members of the congregation maintain an all-night vigil including visiting the Stations of the Cross.

<u>Good Friday, 7 PM March 30th</u>: This solemn service commemorates Christ's sacrifice for us on the cross. We are offered the opportunity to venerate the cross in silence.

<u>Easter Vigil, 8 PM March 31st</u>: This Saturday evening service is the first service of Easter. This wonderful service features the lighting of the Paschal candle and the sharing of its light among the congregation, the reading of Scripture that illuminates "God's saving deeds in history," the ringing of bells, and the proclamation that "Christ is risen."

<u>Easter Sunday, April 1st</u>: During our regular 8 AM and 10 AM services, we affirm that "the Lord is risen indeed." These services are family-friendly; all are invited to participate. Nursery care is provided for children under the age of three during the 10 AM service.
