<u>Service Dog Information</u>: Patients with "invisible diseases" such as diabetes and seizure disorders are often aided by the use of service dogs. At Holy Family, we welcome service dogs during worship and at all activities. The best way to help members or visitors with service dogs is to respect their space and right to privacy. Children and adults are encouraged to avoid calling a service dog's name, petting or touching the dog in any way, whistling, or otherwise trying to get the dog's attention. These behaviors could distract a service dog from doing his or her work which is usually life-saving. A helpful handout about service dogs is available at our welcome desk.
