Haiti Pilgrimage: From July 25-30, members of the diocese's Global Missions Commission will lead a pilgrimage to visit partners in Haiti, including St. Andres in Mithon, where the Diocese of Indianapolis built a school in the aftermath of the 2010 earthquake, St. Vincent's Center in Port-au-Prince, and St. Croix Hospital in Leogane. <u>AED Project</u>: When a person suffers cardiac arrest, survival depends on the ability of bystanders to act immediately. Simply performing hands-only CPR can double or even triple a victim's chance of surviving the event. Having an automated external defibrillator (AED) close at hand can also greatly increase the chance of survival. The Vestry is raising funds to purchase an AED that will be located in the Narthex. The total cost of this project is estimated to be less than \$1500, and any contribution you can make would be greatly appreciated.
