Simply performing hands-only CPR can double or even triple a victim's chance of surviving the event. Having an automated external defibrillator (AED) close at hand can also greatly increase the chance of survival. The Vestry is raising funds to purchase an AED that will be located in the Narthex. The total cost of this project is estimated to be less than \$1500, and any contribution you can make would be greatly appreciated. We have currently raised \$455 toward this project.
