Outreach Opportunities

June Outreach - Otterbein Clothing Ministry: For the month of June we will focus our support toward the Otterbein Thrift Store in Indianapolis. The store receives calls to help families that have experienced house fires and homelessness. The store sells clothes priced at 25 cents per item, or if cash is low, customers are encouraged to take what they need for free. The biggest clothing needs are undergarments for the entire family, men's jeans waist 36 to 38, and plus-size clothing. A collection basket is available in the Narthex.





This year's "Serving in the Circle City" mission trip crew performed over 594 total hours of service work in Elwood and Indianapolis, serving the needs of others in the name of Christ.
