



Trunk or Treat 2020

Friday, October 30th 6-8 PM

A Trunk or Treat event involves the open trunk of a car, displaying candy, and often games and decorations. Some regard trunk-or-treating as a safer alternative to trick-or-treating, while some parents see it as an easier alternative to walking the neighborhood with their children. Hand sanitizer stations will be available throughout the event.

In advance:

- Sign up to host a haunted trunk [HERE](#).
- Choose your theme and include it on the registration form. *Please avoid duplications.*
- Make, collect, or buy supplies to decorate your display. *(Ideas are attached.)*
- Buy candy or non-candy treats (such as stickers, pencils, small toys, etc.) to hand out from your display. *All food items must be store-bought and individually-packaged.*

At the event:

- Decorate/set up your display between 4-6 PM.
- Wear a costume or dress up to match your display.
- Hand out candy and/or other treats during the event from 6-8 PM. *All hosts must wear a mask and gloves for the entire event.*
- Following the event, take down your decorations. Consider storing them for future events! *Please throw away any trash in the church dumpster at the end of the parking lot.*

What kind of themes can I use?



A quick internet search will provide lots of ideas for how to decorate your display. You can even purchase a kit of supplies if you want to save time! Because Holy Family's event is for children of all ages, please refrain from overly-scary or gruesome decorations and themes. Please note that displays do NOT need to be about Halloween and can include other themes such as TV shows, movies, superheroes, historical events, Bible stories, etc.
