Clergy Conference Report – Mar 11-13:

- Bishop notified that confirmands must be 16, but 14 and 15 year old members can petition

- The two Indiana Diocese are still in discussions on reunification, but more likely pointing toward mutual ministries and partnering on initiatives.
- Reunification committee members likely to visit individual parishes to provide updates and seek feedback.

- Discussions with Episcopal Relief and Development to plan for potential unrest around November 2024 elections.
