Journey Through Advent Adult Forum: Join me for the next series in our Adult Forum program, Journey through Advent. Advent is the first season of the Church Year, beginning with the fourth Sunday before Christmas and continuing through the day before Christmas. The name is derived from a Latin word for "coming." The season is a time of preparation and expectation for the coming celebration of Jesus' nativity, and for the final coming of Christ "in power and glory." The dates for Adult Forum are: Sunday, December 7<sup>th</sup>, Wednesday, December 10<sup>th</sup>, Tuesday, December 16<sup>th</sup>, and Sunday, December 21<sup>st</sup>. Advent Compline Online: Compline, also known as Night Prayer, is a brief service in the Book of Common Prayer that takes place at the end of the day. It is a time of reflection and preparation for sleep. Compline is the final prayer of the canonical hours. The word "Compline" comes from the Latin, meaning "completion."
